

# CORONAVIRUS/COVID-19 Update

## *Riverbank Parks & Recreation Parks and Programs*

Beginning May 14, 2020 the following park amenities will open, while others remain closed:

### Riverbank Parks

*Please note:* Park use is **“At Your Own Risk” due to COVID-19**. Park regulations will be posted at all parks, and are listed below. Regulations must be respected by park users, or parks will close. Thank you for your cooperation.

#### OPEN:

- Walking paths at open parks (Jacob Myers Park opens Saturday May 16<sup>th</sup>. Please see regulations below for more details.)
- Open spaces for walking
- Park Restrooms
- Tennis Courts
- Basketball Courts
- Skate Park
- Online program registration for summer programs!
  - Summer Camps, Aquatics, and other programs will remain OPEN this summer! Modifications will be in place to accommodate the current health crisis. Feel free to email [jpetit@riverbank.org](mailto:jpetit@riverbank.org) for specific questions.

#### CLOSED:

- Jacob Myers Park will be closed until May 16<sup>th</sup> when it will open with precautions. Please see regulations below for more details.
- All park playgrounds
- City offices (to the public- feel free to give us a call though!)

#### JACOB MYERS PARK (Scheduled to open May 16, 2020 with precautions)

- Parking capacity will be limited.
- Once capacity is reached **NO ADDITIONAL VEHICLES** will be allowed to enter the park.
- **No walk-ins** will be allowed once the vehicle capacity is reached.

- Friday-Sunday, the normal entrance fee of \$7/vehicle will be in place.
- For those walking the trail, you may receive a “one-hour” pass for free. However, if parking lot nears capacity, free “one-hour” parking passes will not be distributed.
- Dog Park: CLOSED
- McRitchie Trail: open with regulations in place
- Boat launch: open with regulations in place
- Restrooms: open with regulations in place
- Barbeque areas: CLOSED
- Playground: CLOSED

## **REGULATIONS FOR PARK USE**

- Maintain social distancing (6 feet apart)
- Wash your hands and/or use hand sanitizer for 20 seconds regularly, and especially before and after touching surfaces
- NO LARGE GROUP GATHERINGS- gather with members of your same household, and the number in your group must be less than 10 people
- Wearing a mask is highly recommended
- Respect signage for park areas that remain closed
- If park regulations are not followed, parks will close

## **Riverbank Parks & Recreation Programs**

- Swim Team Tryouts will be postponed until further notice. (Updated 5/14/2020)
- Summer Camps and Aquatics programs will take place with modifications to accommodate the current health conditions.
- Programs that are normally inside may take place outside
- Registration is available online only until our offices re-open to the public. Please give us a call if you have any questions at (209)863-7150
- “Dive in” Movie at the Pool is Cancelled ☹️
- Movies at the Park will take place with social distancing regulations in place
- Riverbank Summer Concert Series will be postponed to September 2020 with social distancing regulations in place

This information is subject to change, and programs could open or close if conditions change. We encourage your families to take precautions to prevent the spread of germs during this time. Feel free to register online for swim lessons, summer camps, swim team, and more.** If program cancellations occur due to COVID-19, all participants will receive a **full refund**. In the meantime, grab your child's spot! Summer programs fill up fast.

**If families have any specific needs during this time of cancellations of schools, offices, programs, etc., please give the Parks and Recreation office a call!** We can assess situations and provide resources accordingly. It is our priority that our senior population and children have access to food and needed supplies during this time.
