Preparations for the meeting are conducted between 5:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m. and therefore the City Clerk is not available during this time.</p>
Written Public Comments	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Anyone wishing to provide written public comments may do so <u>prior to 5:00 p.m. on the day of the meeting</u> to allow for distribution to the City Council. Comments must specify what agenda item they are referring to. Comments will become part of the record, however, they will not be read aloud at the meeting.
