AB 341 (2011): Mandatory Commercial Recycling Law requires Businesses that generate 4 cubic yards of commercial solid waste or more per week, and Multi-Family Dwellings with 5+ units regardless of the amount of waste generated, to arrange for recycling services.

AB 1826 (2014): Mandatory Commercial Organics Recycling Law requires, on and after January 1, 2019, Businesses and Multi-Family Dwellings of 5+ units that generate 4 cubic yards of commercial solid waste or more per week, to arrange for recycling services for all organic waste.
