JACOB MYERS PARK

This Park is located off Santa Fe Road, over the First Street Bridge to the left, along the Stanislaus River.

AMENITIES:

Large gazebo, playground, finger park (bring your own little plastic cars), wedding gazebo (available for rent), picnic area, open space, restrooms, bicycle and pedestrian trail, and a group camp area (available for rent by Scouts, church groups etc.).
NO JUMP HOUSES ARE PERMITTED AT THIS PARK.

JACOB MYERS WEDDING GAZEBO

The gazebo is located on the trail just southwest of the entrance. Please contact the Recreation office at 209-863-7150 for fees and availability and more information.

CASTLEBERG PARK

This park is located at 8th and Kentucky and offers a playground, large gazebo area, 2 baseball/softball diamonds, basketball courts, restrooms and pedestrian walkway around the park. Jump houses are allowed WITH a permit.
